The EVO family of USB interface desktop readers offer a low cost way of implementing RFID systems for applications such as document management, check out / check in desks, and other solutions where RFID tag data needs to be captured by a laptop, desktop or point of sale computer.

The three readers (LF, HF and UHF) all come with a software development kit allowing users to create RFID reading application and attach via a standard USB 2.0 interface and offer great performance at a low price point (£145 for the LF & HF versions, £480 for UHF).

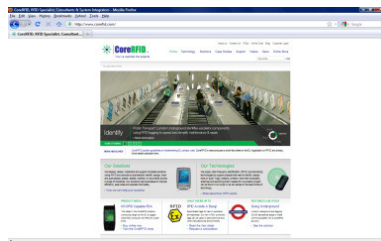
