Safety & Health Expo debut for CheckedOK

Safety checking systems specialist, CoreRFID is launching CheckedOK, their new solution for safety inspection and maintenance management at this year's Safety & Health Expo.

The CoreRFID CheckedOK solution allows maintenance and inspection on tools or other equipment covered by PUWER, COSHH or LOLER to be monitored using electronic or barcode tags to identify equipment and a web-accessible database of results. Information can be used to produce reports and to provide immediate information to management on equipment failing safety inspections or on items which have not been inspected on time.

It can be used in-house or by a maintenance provider to give better information to their customers. The solution works with both barcoding and electronic tags and so it can be used in a wide range of applications. CheckedOK is expected to be valuable in such areas as cranes, slings and lifting equipment; forklifts and loading platforms; escalators and moving walkways; lifts and hoists; boilers, valves and other pressure checked equipment; local exhaust ventilation, air conditioning, filtration & water systems; safety netting & fall arrest installations; hazchem & biohazard handling installations; fire safety & escape equipment. The CheckedOK system already includes inspection menus for over 50 different equipment types.

The database for the CheckedOK solution collects details of inspections and produces necessary reports. It can run on the customer's own computer systems or, more often, it can be delivered as a managed service, making the system easy to introduce and also readily accessible to customers and managers through its web browser interface.
